



Childwall Abbey School Catch up funding 2017-18

During the academic year 2017-18, focused intervention for learners identified as requiring individual support for Literacy and Numeracy, took place throughout the school, largely with the support of the Pupil Premium.

C.A.S. received an additional allocation of funds, to support pupils in Year 7 who had not achieved at least Level 4 in reading/ and or maths, at the end of Key Stage 2 (KS2).

This funding was used to supplement staffing and enable pupils to access additional 1 to 1 and small group interventions as necessary. (£5,000)

An amount was also used to support staff training and resources to develop literacy skills. (£1,100)

Another amount was allocated to support the extension of resources for the weekly Numeracy morning. (£500)

Total Year 7 catch up funding grant for 2017-18 £6,600

The overall impact of the Year 7 Catch Up Funding on progress and achievement was:

Literacy:

- 11% made expected progress
- 56% made better than expected progress

Numeracy:

- 29% made expected progress
- 59% made better than expected progress

Overall, pupils were able to engage with greater confidence with these key areas of the curriculum, with noticeable improvements in terms of pupils' self-esteem and emotional readiness to work.
